

FLAGGER'S CERTIFICATION

Course Description –

The National Safety Council (NSC) endorses and requires this training for all persons who work in, around and regulates traffic during the job.

The first thing covered is who and what the flagger protects, and then the proper equipment needed for a person flagging traffic. The set-up of a flagger station and proper signaling operations is shown with the aid of a Power Point presentation. Lastly, emergency situations are discussed.

The student takes a test and the results are sent to the NSC for review. They then mail a certification card good for 3 years. It is strongly emphasized in class that this card is required by the state and should be carried by all who work in traffic.
