In order to apply, applicants must appear in person and bring the ORIGINAL of ALL the documents listed below. If you do not have **ALL** the documents, you will not be able to apply.

- **A valid CDL-A driver's license with air brake endorsement. NO PERMITS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- Original Social Security Card
- Resume
- Original high school diploma, G.E.D. or original transcript in a sealed envelope from the educational institution. Absolutely no copies will be accepted. If you have a transcript, **DO NOT** make a copy, copies will be made when you apply.
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Cashier's check or money order in the amount of \$25.00 made payable to IBEW Local 9 Apprenticeship Fund. NO personal checks will be accepted.

Study Guides will be available for \$15.00. Please bring a separate cashier's check or money order. NO personal checks will be accepted.
